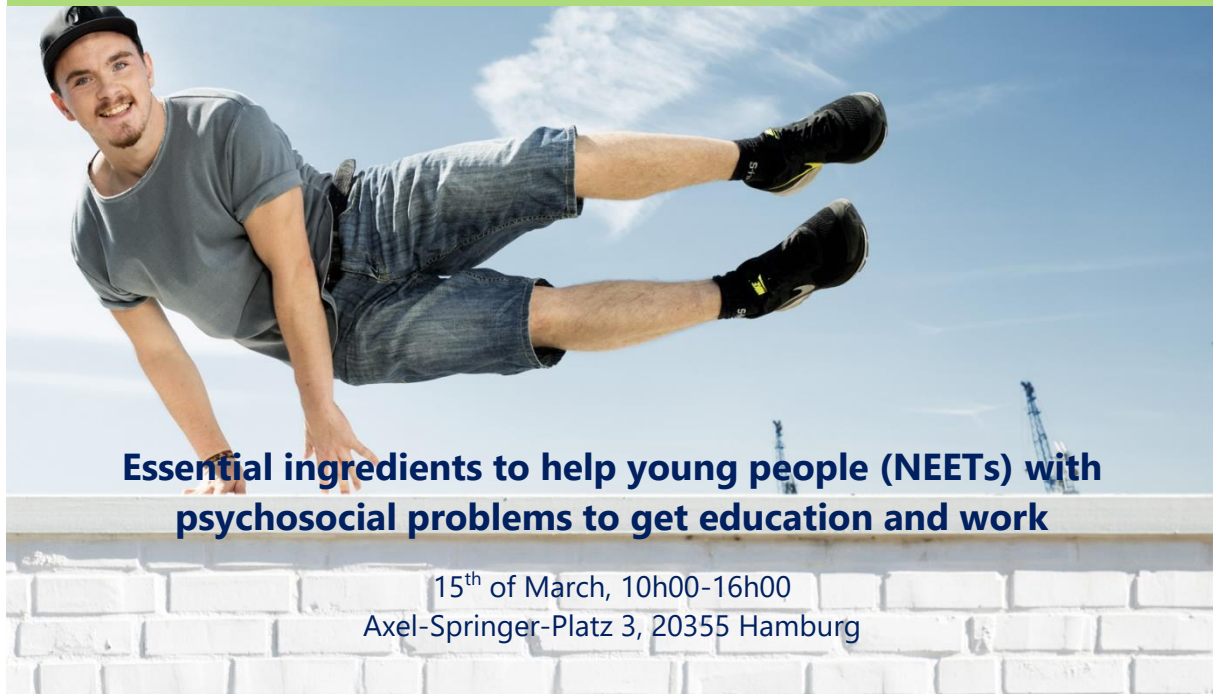


The project Come In by GSM in cooperation with the project Supported Education in Civil Society (SECiSO) invites you to our Transnational Conference:



Introduction

Destination of the conference, the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg, is the second-largest city of Germany and one of the 16 states of Germany, with a population of roughly 1.8 million people. Situated on the river Elbe, Hamburg is home to Europe's second-largest port and a broad corporate base.

Hamburg has a recent youth unemployment quote of 5.5 percent. Main reasons identified are problems in the transition from school to work such as the social and vocational integration just as psychosocial problems that increased in the last years drastically.

The SECiSo (Supported Education in Civil Society) project, ESF founded, is a transnational cooperation, which aims at bringing in civil society as a complementary source for support to school leavers and NEETS with psychosocial problems and mental health issues. Partners are The Swedish National Association for Social and Mental Health (RSMH) and Hanze University Groningen (the Netherlands) and GSM Training & Integration GmbH (Project Come In), Hamburg (Germany).

With the conference we want to introduce you to the Supported Education/ Employment and best practices methods to help young people in the NEET situation and with psychosocial problems to get and stay in education and work.

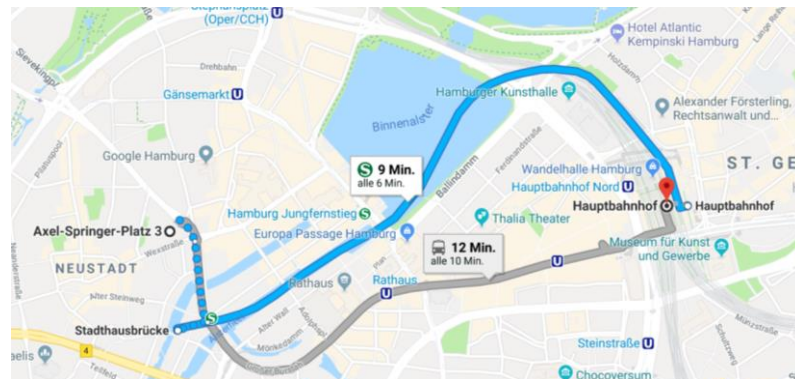
